Where do the training courses take place?

When do I / my employees need training?

- If you have a complex test facility, your staff must be able to handle the test equipment competently and safely.
- If you have to fulfill new testing tasks, your staff need to be able to set up new test procedures on the testbed.
- If new legislation is introduced you and your staff will have to get familiar with new test equipment and to adapt your test procedures.
- If you want to minimize stoppages due to system faults, your team – or your maintenance department – need to be able to recognize and repair the fault.

What do training courses cost?
